Greetings Parents and Guardians:

The Astoria Schools will be utilizing the remote learning procedure as accepted by the Illinois State School Board. We will be allowed to use up to 5 remote learning days during the school year for days that school will not be open due to reasons deemed necessary by school administration due to weather or other unforeseen reasons. On remote learning days, students will have access to materials via the Internet or paper copies of required schoolwork. Teachers will be available via email during these days from 8:00am to 3:00pm. Students will be required to complete the assignments provided by teachers in order to earn a grade for that assignment. Students will be given 5 days to complete the work assigned during remote learning days in order to have the opportunity to ask their teacher questions face to face upon returning to a regular school day. Again, teachers will be available via email to answer questions as well.

Elementary Students: will be given homework assignments by their teachers. These assignments will be aligned to what the students are currently doing in class. No quizzes, assessments or tests will be given on a remote learning day.

Junior High Students: will be given assignments that are directly tied to their core classes. For example science, language arts, and social studies may have a single assignment that is cross-curricular that would fulfill the requirement of those teacher's needs. Math may have an assignment that is separate from the other core classes. No quizzes, assessments or tests will be given on a remote learning day.

High School Students: first remote learning day will consist of a SAT review for all levels of high school; this assignment will be graded as a homework grade. After the first remote learning day, homework assignments will be given based on a schedule that includes 4 classes per remote learning day.

Remote Learning Day 2- 1, 3, 5, 8 periods

Remote Learning Day 3- 2, 4, 7, 9 periods

Remote Learning Day 4- 1, 3, 5, 8 periods

Remote Learning Day 5- 2, 4, 7, 9 periods

No quizzes, assessments or tests will be given on a remote learning day.

It is our hope that we do not need to use any of these remote learning days, but if necessary, we will be prepared and ready to utilize them this school year.
